

Use the CLEER Program to pay for your energy savings improvements, solar installations, or combined heat and power projects with no cash out and no cash flow impact

By using a Commercial Loan for Energy Efficiency and Renewables (CLEER), you could potentially have no out-of-pocket costs and no cash flow impact on your business. With CLEER, you can use the energy savings to cover the costs of the improvements. You can then deploy the cash you would have used for these improvements to other business needs.



No money down. Repayment from energy savings and no cash flow impact.

CLEER is designed to work with Pepco's Energy Savings for Business Program, Washington Gas's Maryland Energy Savings Program, and solar-only installers. You can use a CLEER loan to cover costs not paid for by the utility's incentives, plus you can include up to 50% of the projected incentives in loan proceeds. You can set the payment terms of the CLEER loan so that energy savings will cover the debt service on the loan. Thus, no money out and no cash flow impact. And you get all the energy savings and comfort improvements from the work!

Don't let lack of cash stop you from making the decision to contribute to your company's bottom line!

With CLEER used for energy saving improvements:

- You save dollars for other business needs.
- > The money saved with the energy improvements can go toward the costs of financing the project.
- You benefit from a quick and easy application process.

What does CLEER offer?

- > Up to a \$250,000 loan amount
- > Covers: energy efficiency, solar PV, energy storage, gas furnaces and boilers, combined heat and power
- > PLUS: 30% of loan can cover non-energy efficiency improvements
- > PLUS: 50% of incentives can be included in the loan
- > 100% financing no out-of-pockets
- No additional debt on property (based on credit)
- Loan terms up to 12 years to match energy savings to loan payments

How do you get a CLEER loan?

CLEER is offered through two participating lending partners, Ascentium Capital and Revere Bank. They handle the underwriting and closing of the loans. See lender for current interest rates (contact information on reverse side).
